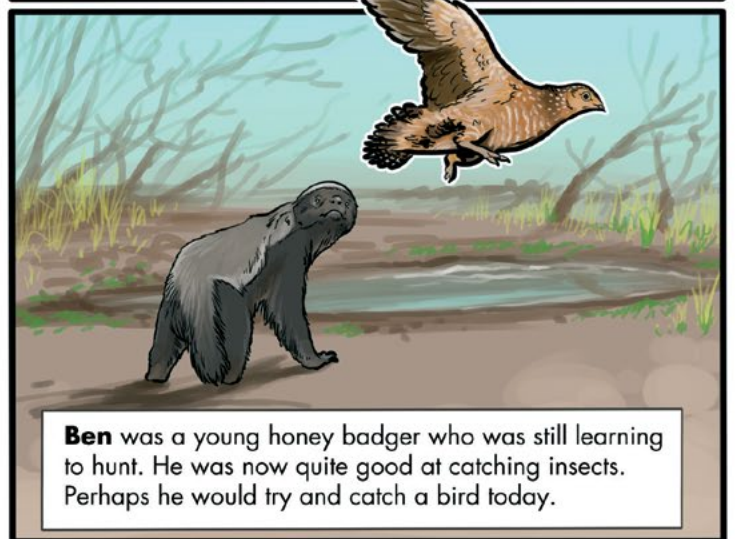
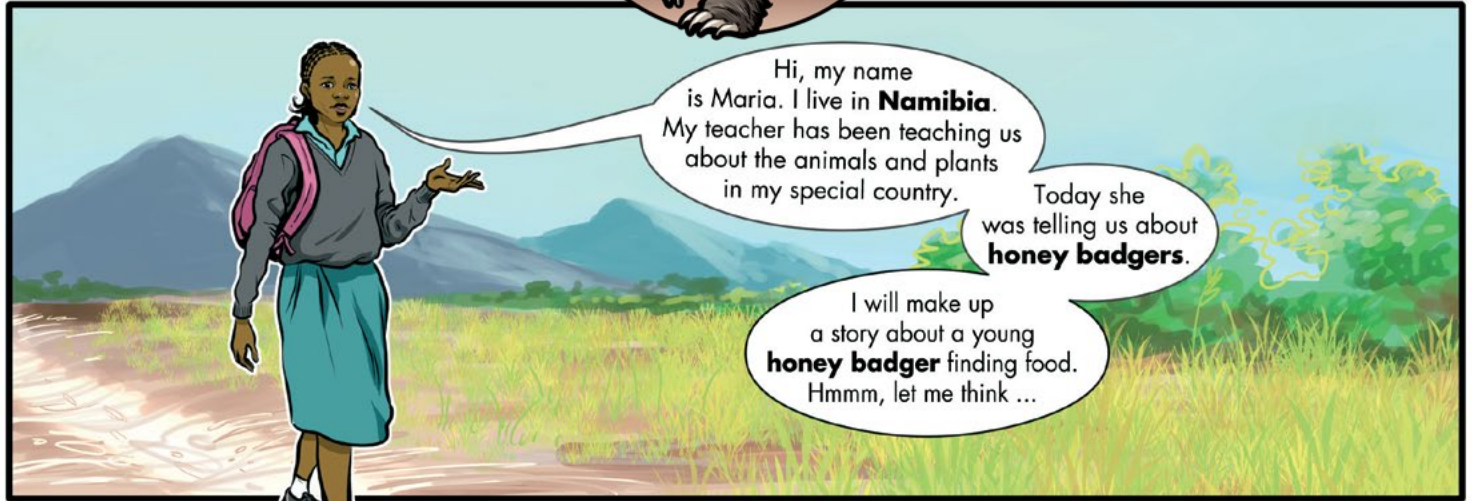


What Animals Eat

Honey badgers are useful to other animals

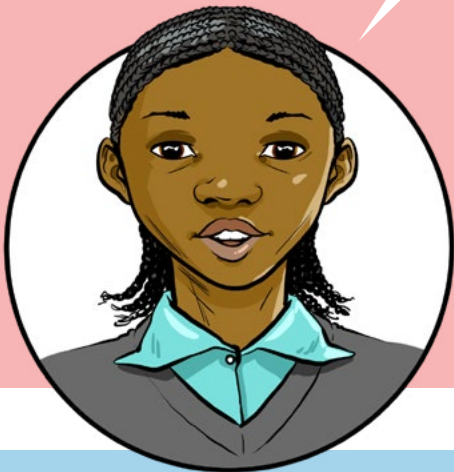

Some animals only eat one kind of food. For example, the black rhinoceros eats only bushes and the white rhinoceros eats only grass.

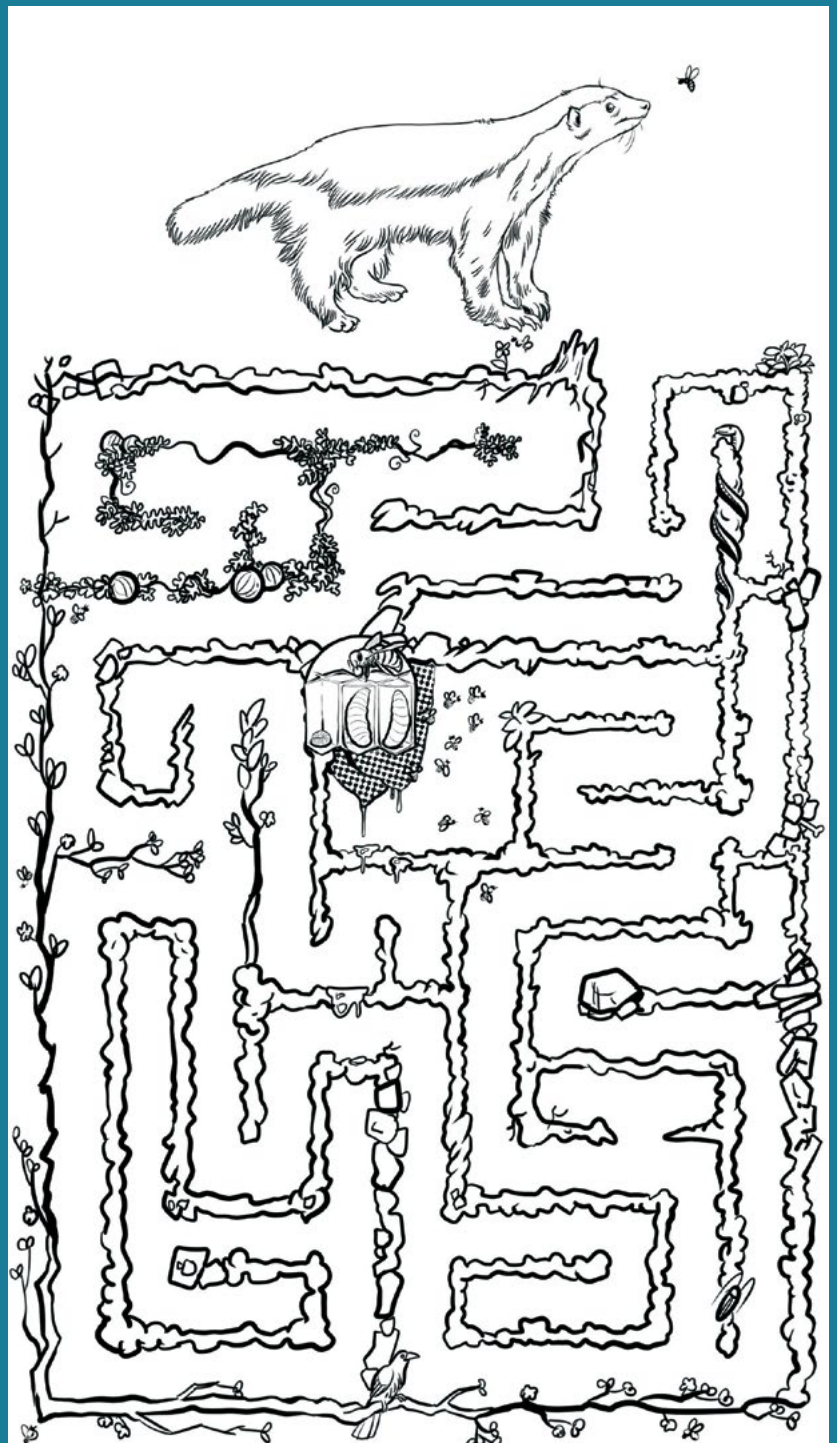
If you could choose only one food to eat, what would it be?
